The American Italian Heritage Museum and Association has a membership drive underway. The museum, which is a center of Italian culture, is the largest museum of its kind east of the Mississippi. Its exhibits are an unparalleled display of Italian artifacts; several rooms contain pictures of Italians and Italian Americans who have contributed so much to Italian culture and history; the museum contains a library of several thousand books on Italian history, culture and famous Italians and there is a great deal of information and statistics having to do with the Italian immigration to America. The museum contains a special exhibit room which is revised bi-monthly, has a gift shop, publishes a bi-monthly newsletter, shows Italian movies, conducts Italian language classes and conducts information and social events throughout the year. 
VOLUNTEER OF THE MONTH



ENRICO FERMI-FATHER OF THE ATOMIC BOMB

Enrico Fermi was born in Rome in September, 1901. He graduated from the University of Pisa in 1922, and after two years of study in Germany and the Netherlands he became a lecturer at the University of Florence. In 1926 he was appointed lecturer in physics at the University of Rome. Dr. Fermi gained world fame in 1934 for a series of experiments at the University of Rome that led to the discovery of uranium fission which in turn ultimately led to the development of the atomic bomb and atomic power plants. He was awarded the Nobel Prize in 1938. Displeased with the Mussolini regime , he left Italy, came to the United States and joined the physics faculty at Columbia University. He soon became the leader of a group of scientists who envisioned the possibilities of an atomic bomb. The first atomic "pile" was built at the University of Chicago in 1942 under Dr. Fermi's guidance. This demonstrated the feasibility of a self-sustaining nuclear chain reaction which opened the door to the new age of industrial atomic power. After three years on the atomic bomb project, Dr. Fermi joined the Institute of Nuclear Studies at the University of Chicago where he continued his work on nuclear physics. In November, 1954 he was the winner of the first special award of \$25,000 given by the U.S. Atomic Energy Commission for outstanding achievement in the field of atomic energy. Another great name in our great heritage.
