SUNDAY BREAKFASTS ARE BACK






VOLUNTEER OF THE MONTH



MEET LUIGI DEL BIANCO


Luigi Del Bianco was born on a ship near France as his parents were returning from the United States to Italy. As a boy Luigi became interested in carving so his father took him to Austria to study under a skilled stone carver. Several years later Luigi's cousins in Barre, Vermont wrote that skilled stone carvers were needed so seventeen year old Luigi headed to America. Throughout the 1920s Luigi worked on several projects under the direction of his mentor Gutzon Borglum, an association and friendship that lasted until Borglum's death in 1941. Del Bianco assisted Borglum with the Stone Mountain project in Georgia and also the Wars of America Memorial in Newark, New Jersey. In 1933 Borglum, the Project Director, hired Del Bianco to be the chief stone carver on the Mount Rushmore National Memorial. Del Bianco's job was to carve the refinement of expression or detail in the faces. In 1941 funding for the project ran out and World War II broke out ending any further carving. Del Bianco returned home to Port Chester, New York and carved approximately 500 tombstones out of rough Vermont Marble. On September 17, 2017, the National Park Service dedicated a plague to Luigi Del Bianco Chief Carver on the Mount Rushmore National Memorial. Another great name in our great heritage.


